



## Key Stage 2 SATs results 2018

Following the changes in assessment made by the Department for Education this year. Children are no longer given a level at the end of Key stage 2. The new assessment arrangements show if the children are working at the new Age Related Expectations (ARE). There is also a 'high score' judgement for those pupils who performed particularly strongly in the assessments.

In addition to this there is a scaled score for each subject which can be between 80-120 with 100 being the expected level. The number of children assessed at the end of Key Stage 2 was 4.
