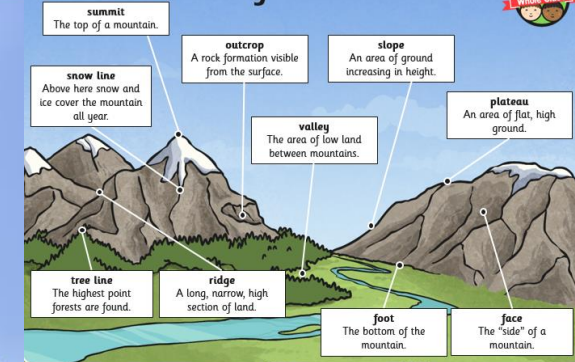

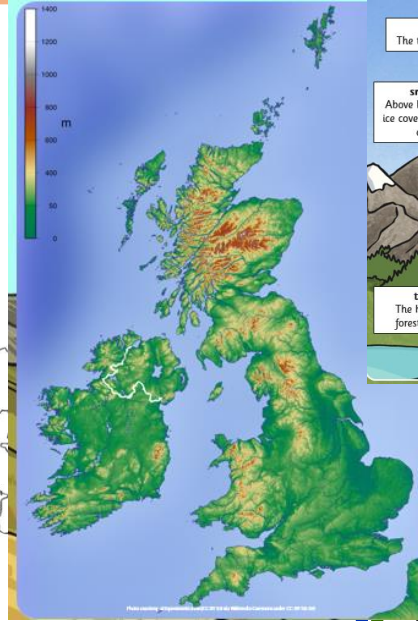
- There are many careers that involve Geography such as:

There are several different types of mountains such as fold mountains and volcanic mountains.
The snowline marks the area on the mountain above which, snow and ice are found all year.
